We have to relocate the monument because it was located on city owned property and after the accident ,which toppled and destroyed the soldier, we were told by the city we could not replace it in the street. The courts have upheld the city's right to do this. We have a lovely place to place it, in the cemetery where the Confederate soldiers of the area are buried. The sculptor is working on the replacement soldier. The broken soldier could not be repaired and, in addition, was dressed in Union attire, so we are replacing him with a valid Confederate soldier. There is a lot of work to be done in the cemetery to place the base in concrete and get the site ready. I cannot say when the work will be completed but can tell you it is ongoing.
