

PRESS RELEASE

The North Carolina Division of the United Daughters of the Confederacy will host a dedication of the Reidsville , NC ,Confederate Monument on Saturday, July 19, 2014, at 2:00 P.M. in Greenview Cemetery , 1004 Montgomery Street, Reidsville , according to Mrs Aileen Ezell, NC Division President 2010-2012, and current Monument Committee chair. The monument is located on the UDC plot, guarding the graves of Confederate soldiers buried there.

The original monument, dedicated in 1910, was struck by a car in an accident in 2011, damaging the soldier beyond repair for use atop the monument. This made it necessary to replace him. The new soldier was designed by Carl W. Regutti of Cary, NC, sculpted of Georgia granite by Mike Jones of Elberton, Georgia, and assembled by Frank Parker , Parker Monuments , of Knightdale, NC.The original broken soldier was donated by the Division to the Historical Museum of Rockingham County.

The ceremony will be conducted by Mrs. Lois Harwood Marlow of Concord, N C. Division President, and past Division president Mrs. Aileen Rodgers Ezell of Canton.

An invitation to attend the ceremony is extended to all who honor those who served in the Confederacy and who appreciate our organization's continuing commitment to the service of these veterans.
